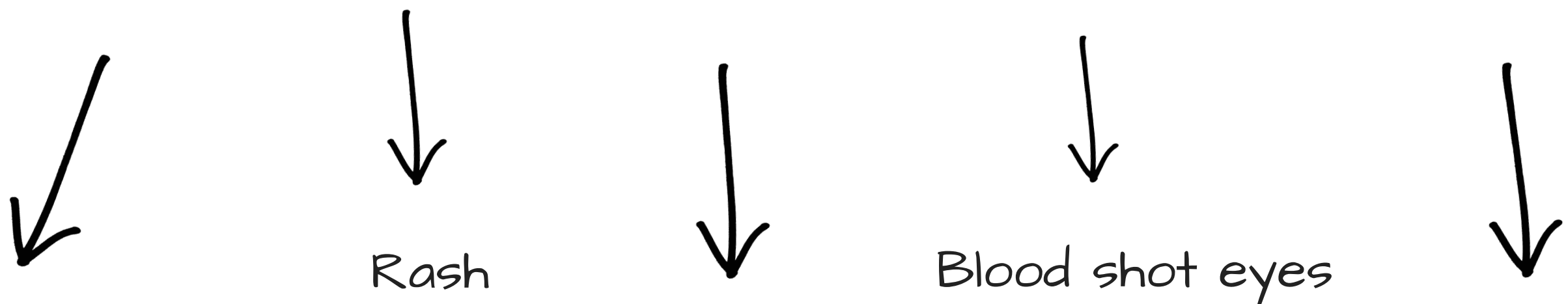

Strawberry Tongue
and red cracked lips

Rash

Swollen lymph nodes
in neck

Blood shot eyes

Red palms/soles
Swollen hands/feet

Kawasaki Disease is a serious illness that causes inflammation in the coronary artery wall. If left unrecognised and untreated it could cause serious damage to the heart.

If your child has had a fever for at least 5 days together with two or more of the symptoms ask your doctor whether he/she could have Kawasaki Disease.
