Tonight, we are delighted to bring together our supporters for the first time since our merger in 2020 created the new Cosmic charity.

Bigger and better than ever, we now proudly support Imperial's Paediatric (PICU) and Neonatal (NICU) Intensive Care Units to provide the best possible care to sick babies and children, as well as to their families and to the frontline staff who care for them.

This evening we celebrate the lives of the children who have been cared for by the remarkable teams at both Queen Charlotte's and St Mary's Hospitals. We also remember those who, despite receiving wonderful care, did not survive as we strive to improve the chances for others.

We would like to thank the incredible staff who work tirelessly to provide world-class treatment for the children under their care. We would also like to thank the parents, families, friends, staff and members of the public who have supported us. Having a child in Intensive Care is every parent's worst nightmare but your kindness and generosity enable us to support families every step of the way.

However, we need your help now more than ever. We want to extend our care to support families in the difficult period following discharge from hospital. Our research shows that, even when a child survives Intensive Care, many parents suffer from Post-Traumatic Stress Symptoms and Disorder (PTSD).

We want to provide families with a comprehensive package of support (please see page 20 for further details). Our research shows that these timely interventions have a real impact on the family's immediate and longer-term well-being. We believe that this innovative programme can inspire a future healthcare model where families are never alone, from hospital to home.

Who we are

Cosmic is an independent charity that is dedicated to providing the best possible care for premature and sick babies and children, as well as for their families and for the frontline staff who care for them.

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It was formed through the merger of two legacy charities, each supporting departments within Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust, London and each founded more than 30 years ago by parents and doctors who knew that more could be achieved with additional funds than the NHS could provide on its own.

The Winnicott Foundation CIO supported the work of the Trust's two Neonatal Intensive Care Units ("NICUs"); one at St Mary's Hospital, Paddington, and the other at Queen Charlotte's & Chelsea Hospital, Hammersmith. Together they form the UK's largest Neonatal Service providing specialist care for new-born babies across North and West London. The Trust also takes in babies from further afield where the transferring hospital does not have the specialist facilities to care for them.

Children of St Mary's Intensive Care supported the Trust's Paediatric Intensive Care Unit ("PICU") at St Mary's Hospital, Paddington. It is the only Unit of its kind in West London – all children admitted here are critically ill and need life-support – and children can be transferred from much further afield, due to the Ward's speciality status. As with the NICU, children can spend anything from a few days to many months on the PICU. Often patients from the NICU are also readmitted here.

The Charity raises funds and helps to provide direct support.





Simon is a Consultant in the Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) at St Mary's Hospital and Adjunct Professor at Imperial College London.

He has worked at St Mary's Hospital since 1991 and been a Consultant since 1994. He was Medical Director of West London Children's Healthcare - the management merger between the Paediatric departments of Imperial NHS Trust and Chelsea and Westminster NHS Trust and was the clinical lead for the PICU.

Apart from his clinical work, he has a major research interest in the causes, treatment and outcomes of critical illness in children. He has been involved in national and international guideline development as well as the design and implementation of major clinical trials in children with critical illness.

Simon has been a Trustee of Cosmic since 2000 and led the project to expand and refurbish the PICU and to create Cosmic House, which was successfully completed in 2019. He has been Chair of the Trustees since 2023.



How we make a difference

Enabling best care

Enhanced training for medical staff

Part of my role is to run weekly simulation sessions for NHS staff so that they can deal calmly and appropriately with the rapid deterioration of a young patient.

With Cosmic's assistance, we have purchased a highly sophisticated medical mannequin for these hands-on training sessions with PICU, A&E and General Paediatrics staff. It's so realistic that we can check breathing with a stethoscope, feel for a pulse, assess pupil dilation and practise difficult intubation of the airway. It can also show very realistically a child with different types of seizures.

All of this helps to make training as realistic as possible so that the team can learn to focus in a stressful scenario. It also gives every member of the team confidence to challenge a course of treatment, if necessary.

With Cosmic's help I also attended a Critical Care Renal Conference last year. With leading delegates from across the world, it was a unique opportunity to share best practice in the treatment of kidney conditions. I've used this knowledge to improve the management of my patients in the PICU, ensuring that we always provide the best possible care.

New equipment

The Milk Bank at Queen Charlotte's Hospital is the oldest in the UK, established in 1939 to help feed quadruplets. Today it provides pasteurised donor breastmilk to the smallest and most vulnerable babies who are cared for on the NICU.

Mothers who have given birth prematurely often experience delayed breast milk production. Their first milk is called colostrum which is rich in nutrients but available only in tiny quantities. Their more mature milk will usually come in 3 to 5 days later. However, premature babies need larger volumes of milk from the very start to manage their transition from the womb. Where their mother cannot initially provide it herself, The Milk Bank provides donor breastmilk to bridge this gap.

There is strong evidence that human milk is better digested and tolerated than cow's milk (which is usually the basis for formula). It also carries extra protection against infection and can help reduce the risk of necrotising enterocolitis (NEC) – a potentially lethal disease of the gut. Donor milk allows medical teams to feed premature babies earlier, promoting growth and development, while avoiding the risk of infection from "long-line" feeding.

The Breastfeeding Support Team work with new mothers to help them to continue breast feeding once they are able to and hospitals with access to Milk Banks tend to have higher success rates in supporting mothers to breastfeed.

Not all Neonatal Units have a Milk Bank and so we are grateful that Cosmic funded its refurbishment last year, ensuring that we can continue to provide this crucial service to both babies and mothers.

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Making progress

Supporting progress so that care remains best in class

When we arrived at Queen Charlotte's Hospital for a routine pregnancy scan little did we know that our lives would be turned upside down.

The Consultant told us that our baby was underweight, weighing less than 500g. She was given only a 50% chance of survival and, even if she did beat those odds, we were warned of potential complications. The world seemed to stop - we felt numb and then terrified.

We'd never even heard of a Neonatal Unit before but the doctors gave us confidence to go ahead with her delivery even though I was only 26 weeks pregnant.

On 27 October 2017 at 13.02hrs our little miracle, Lilliana, was born weighing just 484g. She spent over four months in hospital but has since grown to become a confident and funny six-year-old, bursting with energy.

She wouldn't have survived without the dedicated staff and specialised equipment of the Neonatal Unit at Queen Charlotte's. We wanted to give something back to the hospital to say "thank you". Our Consultant, Dr Sunit Godambe, wanted to trial a project at the hospital aimed at the early detection and treatment of ROP (Retinopathy of Prematurity). ROP is one of the leading causes of preventable blindness in premature babies because the blood vessels in their retinas are more likely to grow abnormally.

With a special mobile camera, nurses could be trained to take high-quality photographs of the back of the babies' eyes that could then be reviewed remotely by an ophthalmologist, making diagnosis and treatment much faster. We fundraised for this cutting-edge equipment and are delighted that this successful trial has led to a permanent improvement in care.

Accommodation

Providing on-site accommodation for parents - Cosmic House

Last summer, our then 12-year-old daughter, Ava, had a major seizure following a bout of food poisoning. She was taken to our local hospital but quickly deteriorated and went into cardiac arrest. It took the medical team twenty minutes to resuscitate her before transferring her to the specialist PICU at St Mary's.

Initial scans showed that the lack of blood supply had caused extensive damage, so the PICU team used Neuro Protection techniques to keep Ava cool to prevent her brain from swelling. She was in the PICU for a week – we couldn't contemplate going home, not least because we live outside of London. We were so grateful when we were given some keys for Cosmic House – the on-site accommodation for parents of children on the St Mary's PICU. It meant that we could take turns to sleep, make food or even spend a private moment away from the PICU while the other remained at Ava's bedside.



Thankfully, Ava's treatment in the PICU was successful. Only when she was transferred to another hospital for neuro rehabilitation did we truly realise how fortunate we'd been to have Cosmic House – the only way to stay with Ava then was to sleep on a camp bed on the ward whilst machines and monitors bleeped all around us.

We'd have done anything to stay with Ava during her time in hospital and we are so grateful for the care that she was given. However, Cosmic House is an amazing resource which enabled us to stay strong for Ava when she needed us most.

I was admitted to my local hospital with pre-eclampsia at 24 weeks' pregnant. Two weeks later on 27th December 2021 our daughter, Zoey, was born. She weighed just 480g.

We were transferred to another hospital with a Neonatal Unit and Zoey appeared to be making good progress despite her prematurity. However, by the end of April she became ill with chronic lung disease and sepsis, so was transferred to the PICU at St Mary's for specialist care.

We spent seven months on the St Mary's PICU. Jo, the Family Liaison Nurse, gave me a room in Cosmic House for as long as I needed it. I don't know how we'd have managed without it as home was two train journeys and a taxi ride away! My husband had to work and so could only visit us at weekends but at least I could stay with Zoey. It also meant that I could cook myself a meal and do my laundry – the practical things that you don't think about until you're in that situation.

It was hard being away from home for such a long time but the nurses, doctors and Cosmic team became our family. They took such great care of us that I felt less anxious on the few occasions when I returned home for a night - I knew that Zoey was in safe hands. They also looked after my wellbeing, whether through counselling sessions or even massage therapy - they couldn't have done more and we will be eternally grateful for their support.

In the November Zoey was well enough to be transferred out of PICU to another hospital and on 27th December 2022 – her first birthday – we finally took her home for the first time!

Our daughter, Gigi, was 8 months old when she caught Covid. She then developed Croup and was soon struggling to breathe. She spent the night in the High Dependency Unit at Chelsea & Westminster Hospital but her situation spiralled - within 48 hours she was intubated and emergency transferred to the specialist Paediatric Intensive Care Unit at St Mary's.

Gigi spent 5 days in Intensive Care during which time her lungs collapsed, resulting in severe respiratory failure and requiring multiple chest drains. She was critically ill and we never wanted to leave her side.

Being in an Intensive Care Unit is an intense experience – every parent is in crisis and the wards are constantly attended by nurses and doctors watching monitors and responding to bleeping machines. We were so grateful when we were offered the use of Cosmic House. We could sleep, shower or prepare food (that hadn't been bought at the coffee shop downstairs), whilst knowing that we could be back by Gigi's side in a heartbeat.

St Mary's worked with Great Ormond Street Hospital where Gigi was then transferred - originally to use their ECMO (life support) machine but, thankfully, she improved enough so this wasn't required. After another 4 weeks she was discharged from hospital and has since made a full recovery. We can't thank enough the incredible medical teams who cared for her.

We are also grateful to Cosmic for providing the specialist medical facilities that kept Gigi alive in Intensive Care. And we remember with fondness the home comforts provided by the Cosmic team during the worst time of our lives, giving us some unexpected respite away from the Intensive Care environment.

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Caring for the carers

Supporting medical teams with equipment, training and well-being

I moved to St Mary's a year ago because of the hospital's reputation as a pioneer in developmental and family-centred care.

This means that they are not just focused on saving lives but also on creating an environment that minimises stress and makes the baby and their family feel comfortable and secure. This is proven to achieve better long-term outcomes.

Cosmic helps us to deliver this by providing equipment such as nests for cots (which help tiny babies feel secure) and "Mini Boos" (a pair of comforters that are swapped between parent and baby so that the baby can smell their parent when separated by an incubator). They also provide reclining chairs for parents so that they can sleep between feeds, as well as Christmas stockings, Mothers' Day and Fathers' Day cards.

But Cosmic also supports us, the medical staff who are providing this care in the most challenging of environments. They give us a training and education budget for specialised courses and conferences that the NHS cannot fund. We bring this knowledge back to the wider team to constantly improve our service. They also focus on staff wellbeing, from funding team breakfasts to refurbishing staff rooms and arranging an on-site osteopath so nurses can decompress from the stresses of the ward. I've also recently asked Cosmic to sponsor our "Employee of the Month" – they present a certificate and chocolates to the winner. It may not sound like much but it is these human touches that make life in Intensive Care more bearable.

Ongoing support

Counselling for families

Our beautiful daughter, Vienna, was just 16 months old when she became ill. We took her to our local hospital where she was eventually diagnosed with Sepsis. However, they couldn't diagnose the cause of her infection and so she was transferred to the specialist PICU at St Mary's. We arrived in the early hours of the morning and were met by the Family Liaison Nurse, Jo.

We hadn't been home for days so she brought us food and toiletries, as well as providing a parent room in Cosmic House so we could freshen up. The PICU quickly diagnosed Vienna with Group A Streptococcal but, tragically, it was too late to save her.

Jo stayed with us throughout our time on the PICU. We had a private room where we could stay as long as we wanted with Vienna. She gave us a memory box so that we could take Vienna's handprints and clay moulds. There was also a book, a blanket, a glass angel and two teddies – one for Vienna and one for us so that we're always connected. We were especially grateful for these when we had to explain to Vienna's 3-year-old brother why she hadn't come home from hospital with us.



Jo kept in touch and introduced us to Cosmic's counsellor. Despite our initial apprehension, we started weekly sessions. It's been invaluable. We're all processing our grief in different ways and at different speeds and trying to do that, whilst also supporting each other, can be challenging. However, the counselling sessions have helped us to keep the lines of communication open and have brought us closer together as a family. We're so grateful to have had access to such incredible support.

Thirteen days after our son, Jimmy, was born, he became extremely ill. He was struggling to breathe and was taken by ambulance to the PICU at St Mary's where he was diagnosed with bronchiolitis and placed in an induced coma.

Over the following weeks Jimmy's condition fluctuated but the level of care he received never did. The team at St Mary's PICU were extraordinary always finding the energy to support us, as parents, as well as care for Jimmy. We found that their kindness, guidance, advice and reassurance were critical to our ability to keep functioning and to take in the medical information that needed to be processed on a daily basis.

Thankfully, after three weeks, Jimmy made it home; just in time for Christmas. He is now a thriving seven-year-old and we will always feel immensely grateful for the outcome of his treatment.

In the aftermath of these events it became clear that the experience had left its scar tissue in us. It is said about severe trauma that "the body keeps score" and the sudden illness of a child can be a uniquely traumatic event. Many families suffer from post-traumatic stress and anxiety after their child has been treated in Intensive Care, even if the outcome is positive. Unchecked, this can have serious implications in the longer term for both the parents and the child. Whilst the care in hospital can be world-class, it often ends when the patient is discharged and it certainly doesn't stretch to the parents' wellbeing.

We wholeheartedly support Cosmic's efforts to implement its innovative plans to support parents of PICU and NICU children as they adjust to life after Intensive Care. We believe that Cosmic's empathetic and research-led approach can mitigate some of the lasting effects of this harrowing experience, providing support that should be accessible to everyone.

The Gardener Schools Group is committed to providing independent education of the highest quality that meets each individual child's needs. The group is comprised of four co-educational schools based in London – Ravenscourt Park Preparatory School, Kew Green Preparatory School and Nursery, Kew House School and Maida Vale School. GSG schools currently educate 1,450 pupils aged 2-18 years. Since 1991, these schools have pursued excellence and innovation while establishing strong family communities at each location.

Support shouldn't stop the day you leave hospital

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More than 95% of children admitted to the Paediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU) will go home. Even premature babies born as early as 23 weeks' gestation can survive after treatment on the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU).

However, there are far-reaching psychological impacts on the child and their family following discharge from hospital.

Up to three quarters of parents and children discharged from PICU have Post-Traumatic Stress symptoms (PTSD), anxiety or depression. Of parents with babies on the NICU, nearly half of mothers and a third of fathers have suffered from psychological symptoms after discharge. This can have lasting effects on both health and family dynamics.

With Cosmic's support, the St Mary's PICU has conducted studies on preventing PTSD in parents and their wider families through early intervention. We found that the most effective preventative method for PTSD is through processing memories, whether by discussing them, or through stories and play in children. Parents say that this helped them to realise that their reaction to their child being admitted to PICU was normal, made them less anxious and more prepared for life after PICU discharge.

These methods resulted in strikingly reduced post-traumatic stress and depressive symptoms six months after discharge compared with standard treatment. Children whose parents received this support also showed lower levels of emotional and behavioural difficulties.

Unfortunately, referrals through a GP for psychological support can take years, leaving families with PTSD symptoms without the necessary support they need.

With your help Cosmic will provide a comprehensive package of support for PICU and NICU families leaving hospital which includes:

- 1. More 'Family Liaison Nurses' to continue communication with families following discharge from the Intensive Care Unit to support and identify families at risk
- 2. An information pack to address any questions and deal with symptoms
- 3. Referrals to a Cosmic-funded psychologist, if required
- 4. A follow up medical clinic with a PICU or NICU Consultant to ensure that support is coordinated and effective
- 5. Organised support groups and family support events

We want to provide a comprehensive healthcare model that inspires adoption across the UK. This will ensure that families who have experienced Intensive Care with their child are never alone, from hospital to home.

Sachin Tendulkar Signed Cricket Bat

Generously donated by Professor David Stringer

This is a unique opportunity to own a signed bat from one of the greatest batsmen in the history of cricket.

Former Indian cricket captain, Sachin Tendulkar, is the all-time highest run-scorer in both One Day Internationals and Test cricket with more than 18,000 runs and 15,000 runs, respectively. He also holds the record for receiving the most Player of the Match awards in international cricket.

Sachin gave two cricket bats to Dr Diane Smyth (at that time a Paediatric Neurologist at St Mary's Hospital) in 2012 - they were carried by a friend from India to London. One was auctioned to raise funds for a children's renal charity. The other was intended to be auctioned at a Cosmic Ball in 2013.

However, the Ball did not take place and so Diane held onto the bat until a suitable charitable event arose – eventually an auction for Hospice Ukraine in 2023. 




